There are a few items that your child will need for the upcoming year:

- A large backpack (without wheels, please, as they do not fit inside the lockers)
- An art smock (a large t-shirt works best) (All other art supplies will be provided.)
- A **complete** change of clothes, each piece **labeled** in a Ziplock bag. (Our outdoor classroom presents fun opportunities that may result in getting wet. Dry sneakers may also be a good idea.)

For example, *How do you see your child as a person and as a learner?* What does your child enjoy? What are your hopes for your child's first grade experience?
