

Supply List For Incoming Fifth Graders 2020-2021

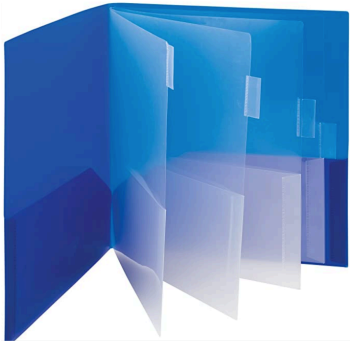
Dear Fifth Grader,
Please take a look at the three options presented for your organizational system. We have given some reasons you might choose each one. **Only purchase one option for the start of the school year.**

Option 1: Pendaflex Folder ([Staples link for purchase](#))



- 13 total sections
- Planner would go inside
- Folder for each section
- Allows additional sections for personal items (artwork, reminders, etc.)
- Useful for students who benefit from having everything in one place
- Downside: computer does not fit, so that must be carried separately

Option 2: Multi-pocket folder, should be plastic coated ([Amazon link for purchase](#))



- 10 pockets for different classes
- Planner would be kept separate
- Downside: This might be an option for more organized people, as too many papers in this would begin to spill out. Also, may not be as durable.

Option 3: Case-It ([Case-it link for purchase](#))



- Accordion section
- 1 folder for each subject
- Inside pocket for school supplies
- Planner and laptop can go inside
- Downside: It can get very heavy and bulky to carry. Also might be difficult to work out of.



Below is the list of all other supplies you will need for the year.

Supplies Used at School (stored and used when necessary)

- 2 boxes of pencils
- Hand-held white board 9 x12
- Personal hand-held pencil sharpener (one that holds the shavings)
- Erasers (either one big one or several pencil toppers)
- Zippered pencil holder (no pencil boxes)
- 1 box of colored pencils
- 4 highlighters
- 12 dry erase markers – 4 should be fine point
- Dry erase eraser
- 4 pens (2 red & 2 black/blue)
- 2 packs of small Post-it notes
- 1 pack of loose-leaf paper, wide ruled, 100 count
- Headphones or ear buds

English Language Arts:

- 2 marble composition notebooks
- 1 two pocket folder (to be left in classroom)

Social Studies:

- Pack of index cards
- 1 marble composition notebook

Math:

- 1 – 12” plastic ruler with inches and centimeters
- TI 108 calculator
- 1 black marble composition notebook
- Dry erase markers

Science:

- 1 wide ruled marble composition notebook
- Hand lens, 3x-6x (optional, for home use)
- Colored pencils
- Hand-held white board 9 x12 (see general supplies above)
- Dry erase markers (see general supplies above)

French/Spanish:

- 1" binder
- 3 dry erase markers to remain In World Language (see general supplies above)
- Earbuds to keep in World Language classroom
- Hand-held white board 9 x12 (see general supplies above)

Items which 5th grade teachers recommend having at home to assist with homework:

- Pencils, erasers, pens, highlighters, colored markers, sharpies
- Post-it notes, index cards
- Scotch tape, ruler, scissors, glue sticks

All items brought to school, including clothing, should be clearly marked with student's name.

Name tags on clothing is **Highly Recommended**, similar to those on <https://www.namebubbles.com/>, or written with a laundry marker, similar to Sharpie's Rub-A-Dub Laundry Marker.
