The upcoming summer vacation is not only the perfect time for your children to play, visit new places, and spend extra time with family and friends – it is also the perfect time to maintain reading momentum and develop new skills. We encourage your child to continue reading independently and for you to continue reading aloud to your child on a regular basis during the summer. Research shows that hearing books read aloud is directly correlated to a child's future academic growth and success in school.

We suggest that you and your children read from a variety of genres such as picture books, poetry, fairy tales, early chapter books ("easy readers"), and non-fiction books. We always encourage students to pursue their own reading interests, but if you want suggestions, Ms. Glynn, Primary School Librarian, has posted a list of recommended books for students at each grade level on the Primary School Library's website. The suggested summer reading list includes a variety of reading levels to support the diverse needs of our students. You can access the suggested summer reading list via the following link:
