



ORDERING BOOKS MKA Middle School

This is a reminder that for the upcoming school year MKA will once again be working with MBS Direct, although they have changed their name to [BNC Services](#). With a few exceptions, books must be ordered online and will be shipped directly to your home. You are, of course, free to write down the book information (look under “Show Details”) and purchase the books elsewhere (e.g., amazon.com, Barnes and Noble, etc.) but be sure to purchase the same edition that BNC is selling so your student can follow along in class or on homework assignments. The BNC Virtual Bookstore will open August 1st. There will be a flat \$5.99 shipping cost throughout the year each time you order.

There are classes that are not listed on the BNC site. These classes may have an online version, which students will get access to in class, or they may receive their books in class and will be charged through their bookstore account, or finally, they may use classroom copies, for which they are not charged.

If there is no class listed on the BNC site, then there are no books to purchase at this time. The bookstore will carry extra copies of workbooks that may get lost during the school year, but limited quantities will be available.

New this year, we are reminding parents that when ordering online access for a student in any course where it is required, you should put the **student's** MKA email address as the required email for access to the online code.

Here are the instructions for ordering books:

Ordering Books from BNC Services

- Navigate to the BNC Services website: <https://bnck-12.com/mka>
- The above link will take you directly to MKA, click ‘Let’s Get Started.’
- Once on the site, click on ‘Select Term’, then ‘School Year 2022-2023’ then click on Middle School and the subjects will appear.

- You can click on all the subjects that you are taking, then hit continue. It should be self-explanatory at that point. Purchase whichever books you need. There is an option to NOT PURCHASE each book, in case you already have it or do not need it.
