S/he will collaborate with other faculty in French on the development of the curriculum across all levels and will collaborate with other faculty in the department on new approaches to language teaching and learning, including new uses for technology in and out of the classroom. Other responsibilities include serving as an advisor as well as, ideally, coaching a sport and/or supervising an extracurricular activity.

Qualified applicants will meet the following criteria:

- BA in French, Spanish, Romance Languages, or related field (MA or MAT preferred)
- Teaching experience preferred
- Experience mentoring students is a plus.

Candidates should possess outstanding interpersonal, communication, and organizational skills; the ability to work with students at all levels; a passion for language and culture education; an enthusiasm for collaborative teamwork; and the ability to integrate the use of technology into classroom instruction.
