### When is the health information due for my child(ren)?

Completed health information for all students is due on or before JULY 25.

Returning students who already have a valid physical on file with the school, do not need to re-submit this and will not have to submit an updated physical until the anniversary of the current physical.

Magnus Health will clearly list all the required information for each of your students, together with the status of each item.

#### Why are there still some paper forms that we need to submit?

Wherever possible we have tried to replace paper forms, with the ability to enter information online, but if a form requires a physician's signature it must be printed out and completed, and then uploaded to your account.

### How do I submit or upload my child's physical or other paper forms?

You can either:

- Upload your form as either a pdf file or picture (<u>how to upload a file or picture</u>)
- Mail or fax your form (how to print the cover sheet)

# How do I change an answer?

Change a response after you have submitted it.

#### What Information will I need to complete?

All children need to have the following information completed:

- Basic Information and Health Questionnaire completed by a parent (online)
- Consent to Treat form (online)
- Over-the-Counter Medication Permission form (online)
- Additional information will be requested for students with specific medical conditions (online treatment plans and prescription medication forms must be printed, completed by a doctor, and then uploaded to your account)

## Pre-K-Grade 5

• Pre-K-Grade 5 Physical form (must be signed by a doctor and then uploaded to your account)

#### Grades 6, 7, & 8

- NJ Annual Athletic Pre-Participation Physical (due on the anniversary of the prior year physical)
- NJ Sudden Cardiac Death Acknowledgement (online)
- NJ Concussion Acknowledgement (online)
- NJ Eye Injury (online)
- NJ Opioid Misuse & Abuse Acknowledgement (online)
- Students participating in athletics are required to update their physical information and read and agree to abide by the Athletic Code of Conduct each season.

#### Grades 9-12

- NJ Annual Athletic Pre-Participation Physical (due on the anniversary of the prior year physical)
- NJ Sudden Cardiac Death Acknowledgement (online)
- NJ Concussion Acknowledgement (online)
- NJ Eye Injury (online)
- NJ Opioid Misuse & Abuse Acknowledgement (online)
- Students participating in athletics are also required to complete the Steroid Testing Permission form, update their physical information, and read and agree to abide by the Athletic Code of Conduct each season.

### Additional Requirements for students new to MKA:

- The school requires a physical performed after March 1. The appropriate form should be completed for all new students (print out, doctor completes form, and then upload to your account)
- Immunization Records (print out, doctor completes form, and then upload to your account)
- Prior School Records request (print out and give to former school to process)
