Qualified candidates will meet the following criteria:

- MA in an area of science or science education;
- 7 years teaching experience (minimum) at the Middle School level;
- Prior leadership experience desired (but not required);
- Interest in coaching a sport or supervising an extra-curricular activity.

In addition, candidates should possess:

- Outstanding interpersonal, organizational and communication skills;
- The willingness to work as a member of a collaborative team;
- An understanding of how to analyze and use data in decision-making;
- A commitment to ongoing growth and development as a teacher and leader;
- The ability to integrate use of technology to enhance student learning in the classroom;
- The ability to organize and facilitate large scale, grade-wide independent research.
